

## DETAILED NOTICE INVITING BID

### 1.0 Invitation:

Sealed bids in English (one original and seven identical copies) are invited by Neyveli India Limited, (NLCIL), Neyveli through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) for Borosilicate Glass Block Lining for flue cans of by Bi-flue Chimney of Neyveli New Thermal Power Project - 2 x 500 MW (NNTPP) located at Neyveli, Cuddalore District, Tamil Nadu State, India as per details give below:-

### 1.1 Tender No.CO CONTS/0001E/NNTPP/Chimney/BS Lining/2017, Dt.10.01.2017.

### 1.2 Introduction:

The NLC INDIA Limited, (NLCIL) is a 'Navratna, Government of India enterprise, registered under the Indian Companies Act 1956, is constructing a 2x500 MW lignite based pulverized fuel fired Thermal Power Station at Neyveli, Tamilnadu, India as a replacement for its existing 600 MW Thermal Power Station-I (TPS-1). The two Units are in advanced stage of construction and are scheduled for Boiler Lighting Up in October 2017 and commissioning of Units 1 & 2 by March & April 2018 respectively. Under Balance of Plant (BOP) Package, Bi-flue chimney of height 275 Metre for the Power Plant is under construction. The construction of concrete shell of the chimney is already completed and erection of two steel flue cans have been started. In order to comply in the MOEF Norms for flue gas emission, a flue gas desulphurization plant (wet FGD) is proposed to be installed in the Power Plant. Hence, NLC India Ltd referred to as "Purchaser" invites to carryout Borosilicate Glass Block Lining of inner surface of flue cans of the Bi-flue Chimney of NNTPP to protect them from wet flue gas.

### 1.3 Brief Scope of Work

The Bidder has to carry out Borosilicate Glass Block Lining of inner surface of flue cans of the Bi-flue Chimney of NNTPP thereby providing complete chimney lining system to protect the Bi-flue cans from wet flue gas from the flue gas desulphurization system.

Detailed scope of work is provided in the Technical Specification & Drawings (Volume-II).

- Part-II** : QR documents, Integrity Pact, Techno-commercial details and Price Schedule along with Form of Bid (ANNEXURE - C).

### 1.6 Information Regarding the Tender:

In such case, the cost of tender document shall be paid by way of Banker's Cheque / DD drawn in favour of NLC India Limited, Neyveli, payable at Neyveli or by NEFT/RTGS mode to NLCIL's Account mentioned above. The DD / Banker's cheque / remittance details with UTR No. in case of payment made by NEFT / RTGS shall be submitted in Part I of the bid. Bid received without the cost of tender documents will be rejected.
- (d) The Bidder is to note that the Bank Commission charges will be to the account of the bidder and the net amount transferred to NLCIL's account shall be equal to the cost of the Tender document.
- (e) The Bid Guarantee shall be either in the form of Bank Guarantee valid for 300 days from the scheduled date of opening of bids or demand draft for an equivalent amount drawn in favour of NLC India Limited, payable at Neyveli.
- (f) Amendments / Errata / corrigendum / clarifications, if any, issued for the tender shall form part and parcel of the tender document. Amendments / Errata / corrigendum / clarifications will be posted on NLCIL's web site/CPPP. Bidders are requested to visit NLCIL's web site/CPPP and note the amendments before submission of offer. NLCIL shall not be responsible if any Bidder omits to notice any amendments / Errata / corrigendum / clarifications. Amendments / Errata / corrigendum / clarifications will be numbered serially. The bidders are requested to sign all the Amendments / Errata / Corrigendum / Clarifications issued


for the tender and enclose along with the bid as these form part and parcel of tender document.
